1. Who is the true spiritual light? Read *John 8:12, John 1:1-5, John 1:14* and *Hebrews 1:2-3*.

2. Who does He reveal to us? Read *2 Corinthians 4:6, Matthew 11:27, John 14:6-7, John 12:44-46* and *John 13:20*.

3. What does that mean for my life? List eleven things. Read *John 1:12-13, John 8:12, John 17:1-5, John 3:16-18, Romans 6:22-23, Romans 8:15-16, Galatians 4:6-7, 1 John 1:7, 1 John 2:1-2* and *Colossians 1:12-23*.



In the natural, when you walk away from the light, you walk in the darkness of your own shadow. As it is in the natural so it is in the spiritual as God created all things.



In the spiritual, when you walk away from Jesus or even just turn your eyes away from Him and onto yourself, you walk in the shadow of spiritual darkness.

Which way you are walking and what you are thinking will direct **where the light** and **darkness falls** in your life.

4. What is spiritual darkness? Read *Acts 26:18, Proverbs 4:19, John 3:19-21, Ephesians 6:12, 1 John 1:6, 1 John 2:9-11* and *Jude 1:4*.

5. Even when you know of Jesus the divine light, can you be spiritually blind? Read *2 Peter 1:5-9*.

6. How do we walk in the light? Read *Hebrews 12:2-3, Psalm 119:105, Matthew 4:4, Matthew 6:33, Ephesians 5:8-21* and *Romans 13:12-14*.



7. What are the 6 parts of the armour of light? Read *Ephesians 6:10-17*.

In the natural, light is stronger than the darkness. The light pushes back the darkness. As it is in the natural so it in the spiritual as God created all things.

8. Jesus the divine light and Lord of eternity has the power over the darkness.

12. Prayer offered in faith.



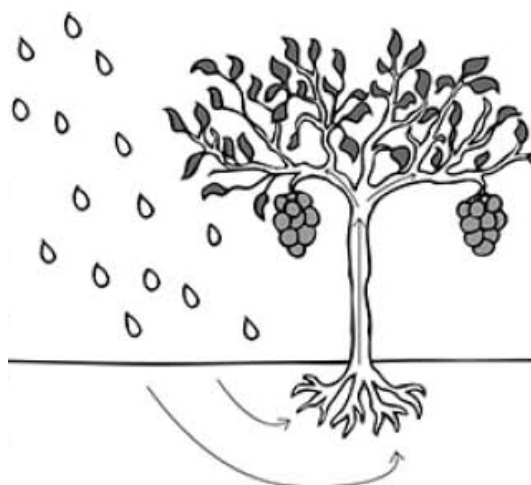
BIBLE STUDY 3: FRUIT

3. What is 'the source' of spiritual fruit? Read *Ezekiel 47:12*

4. How do we produce fruit? Read *John 15:3-5, Hebrews 12:2-3, Psalm 92:13-14, Matthew 13:23, Hebrews 10:22* and *1 John 2:6*.

In the natural, a healthy vine needs to be planted in good, fertile, soft soil. As it is in the natural so it in the spiritual as God created all things. In the Spiritual, Jesus likens good soil to the condition of our heart and a teachable spirit.

5. According to the Bible (God's Word) what is the seed and the ground in the spiritual? Read *Matthew 13:18-23* and *1 Peter 1:23*.

6. How do we grow spiritually? Read *Ephesians 6:18, Matthew 4:4* and *John 4:23*.

In the Spiritual, Jesus' is the source of our food. He is the bread of life and the Word of God. When we are abiding in the vine we are feeding off what Jesus feeds off.

7. What was Jesus' food? Read *John 4:34*.

8. What is the Father's will? *Luke 4:18-19*.

9. You are a branch connected to the true vine. You are hanging there receiving all the vines' goodness. That vine is Jesus. What are some of the names given to Jesus?

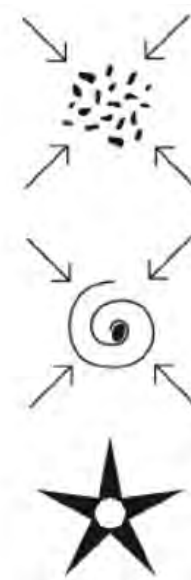


BIBLE STUDY 4: STARS

3. What is the promise for the pure in heart? Read *Matthew 5:8*.

In the natural, a star is formed under great pressure. Without the pressure there is no light. As it is in the natural so it is in the spiritual as God created all things.

2. Let God create one, accept Jesus as the centre of our life and be transformed from glory to glory.
3. See God.
4. Do not fear, in your heart set apart Christ as Lord, always be prepared to give the reason for your hope, keep a clear conscience, be baptised, rejoice and continue to do good.

BIBLE STUDY 5: FISH AND BIRDS

In the spiritual, where there is the greatest spiritual darkness, most people haven't heard the good news that Jesus is the Lord of their destiny and He can set them free from eternal darkness.

1. What is fishing for people? Read *Matthew 4:18-19, Luke 10:1-9, Acts 2:40-41, Acts 5:12-14, Acts 1:8, John 4:39* and *Revelation 12:11*.

2. How can we fish for people? Read *Acts 14:21, Matthew 28:18-20, Mark 16:15-18, Luke 24:46-48* and *John 20:21-22*.

In the natural, there are better times to catch the most fish. As it is in the natural so it is in the spiritual as God created all things.

In the spiritual, there is a time to rest and a time to share about Jesus. To discern the times and the seasons we must be listening to God and be guided by Him.



3. How do we know God's voice? Read *John 10:27, Luke 5:16, 1 Samuel 2:18, 1 Samuel 3:10, Luke 10:39, John 16:13-14* and *Psalms 46:10*.

In the natural, when fishing out in the deep there are predators ready to devour anything and everything. As it is in the natural so it is in the spiritual as God created all things.

In the spiritual, when fishing out in the world there are predators including the devil ready to devour our faith. Trying to stop us believing in Jesus. Trying to stop us trusting in God.

4. When trouble comes from fishing what are some of the promises God has given us? Read *Hebrews 13:5-6, John 16:33, Romans 8:38-39* and *Isaiah 40:26-31*.

In the natural an eagle uses the wind of the storm to fly above it. As it is in the natural so it is in the spiritual as God created all things.

In the spiritual we need to trust God will carry us high above the storm.

5. How can we fly above the storm? *Matthew 6:25-34, Psalm 55:22, 1 Peter 5:7, Romans 5:1-5, Hebrews 12:1-3* and *Proverbs 3:5-6*.



Answers

1. To preach good news to the poor, proclaim freedom, recover sight for the blind, to release the oppressed and to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour, be a witness and testify.
2. Follow Jesus, love God, obey Jesus, feed His sheep, make disciples, baptize, teach, go and be a witness.
3. Following Jesus, prayer, ministering before the Lord, letting Holy Spirit teach to know His voice, sitting at Jesus' feet and being still in His presence.
4. God will never leave us, He will never forsake us, Jesus has overcome the world and nothing can separate us from His love, strength and power.
5. Don't worry, seek first the kingdom of God, cast all burdens on the Lord, have peace, glory in tribulation, fix eyes on Jesus and trust in the Lord.



BIBLE STUDY 6: KINGS AND PRIESTS

3. What are the three temptations known to human kind? Read *1 John 2:16*?

4. How did Jesus resist the three temptations known to humankind?
Read *Matthew 4:3-11*.

In the natural, even before God created man and woman, God gave them everything they would ever need. God created the plants & fruit for food, 3 days before He created man & woman. As it is in the natural so it is in the spiritual as God created all things.



In the spiritual, God has given us everything we need to rule. He has given us the victory of Jesus over death and sickness and the resurrection power of the Holy Spirit.

5. What has God given us to rule and reign over our fleshly desires? Read *Titus 3:5-7, 1 John 3:9, Romans 8:9-11 and Galatians 5:24-25.*

6. What is sufficient for all our humans needs? Read *2 Corinthians 12:9 and Romans 5:1-5.*

7. Why are we given power to rule now on earth? Read *Psalms 8:1-9, Ephesians 4:11-16, Matthew 20:25 and Ephesians 2:4-10.*

In the natural a family name of royal blood can have influence and favour with people. As it is in the natural so it is in the spiritual as God created all things.

In the spiritual when we are part of God's family, He has given us the authority to use His name, the name that is above every other name, that name is Jesus.

8. How do we overcome Satan and the spirits of darkness? Read *Ephesians 6:10-17 Mark 16:17, Acts 3:1-7, Acts 4:30-31, Psalm 103:1-5 and Revelation 12:7-12.*



9. How can we live in victory here and now? Read *John 14:12-13*, *Philippians 4:12-13* and *Romans 8:37-39*.

10. What are the promises God gives to the church that overcomes?

Gifts to build up the body of Christ. Goodness. Righteousness. Truth.



BIBLE STUDY 7: GOD'S REST

Living in God's rest requires trust in God. The good news is, trust starts with knowing God the Father through Jesus His Son.

2. What does it mean to trust God? Read *Philippians 1:6*.

3. Joshua was one of the few who was set free from Egyptian oppression and who entered God's promise land. What does God's promise land represent? Read *Hebrews 4:1, Deuteronomy 12:9* and *Genesis 2:2*.



4. We can enter this rest here and now but there is also a future rest. List some of them. Read *Hebrews 11:16*, *John 14:2-3*, *Revelation 7:15-17* and *2 Timothy 4:7-8*.

5. What did Joshua choose to do? Read *Numbers 14:6-9*.

6. What did God tell Joshua to do especially each time before battle? Read *Joshua 1:6-9*.

7. Who's battle is it? Read *1 Samuel 17:47* and *Colossians 2:11-15*.

Living in God's rest requires faith. The good news is, faith starts with hearing the Word of God.

8. Living in God's rest requires what? Read *Hebrews 4:1-5*.

9. Write in your own words what faith is to you. Read *Hebrews 11:1*.

Living in God's rest requires obedience to God. The good news is obedience starts with receiving God's free gift of love.

10. To enter God's rest is to rest from what? Read *Hebrews 4:6-11*.

11. When we know Jesus and receive His grace and love what happens in our life? Read *2 Corinthians 3:16-18* and *Colossians 2:2*.
