

SCENE 1 = King Nebuchadnezzar's Gods [Daniel 3:1-9]

Long, long time ago there was a king called Nebuchadnezzar. He built a very big gold statue and commanded everyone to bow down and worship the statue and his Gods.

The king said: Anyone who did not worship the statue would be punished. They would be thrown into a fire.

SCENE 2 = Three Boys refuse to worship other Gods [Daniel 3:10-20]

Some of the king's men said to the king: There are three boys who will not worship your statue or Gods.

The king was very angry and yelled at the three boys: If you bow down to my Gods I will not throw you into the fire.

The three boys said: Our God, who we worship, can save us. But even if He chooses not to save us from the fire we will only worship him.

The king was now very, very angry and commanded: Throw the three boys into the fire.

SCENE 3 = Ring of fire [Daniel 3:21-29]

The king's soldiers tied up the 3 boys and threw them into the fire. The fire was so hot that the flames of the fire leaped out and killed the soldiers.

Suddenly the king jumped up and shouted: Wasn't there only three boys in the fire?

The king saw Jesus, the Son of God in the fire with the 3 boys. They were walking around in the fire and talking together.

The king went closer to the fire and shouted: You boys who worship the Most High God come out of the fire at once!

The 3 boys came out of the fire. They were not burnt or hurt in any way.

The king said: Praise their God who saved them from the fire. They trusted their God and chose to die instead of worshiping any other God.

The king said: No other God has such great power to save.

The 3 boys would only worship God even if they got hurt, even if they were sick, even if they were poor. They would not worship any other God because only Jesus has such great power to save.
